WHEREAS, Recent national policies and political rhetoric have generated a toxic environment that encourages the propagation of racist, xenophobic, anti-Semitic, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, Islamophobic and other discriminatory views by emboldened hate groups and individuals; and

WHEREAS, The number of hate crimes committed across the United States has increased dramatically over the past several years, including in San Francisco where hate crimes increased by 61% between 2017 and 2018; and

WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco is a Sanctuary City, and has been a national leader in implementing local non-discrimination policies; and

WHEREAS, In the fall of 2017, when members of white supremacist groups began a campaign to hold rallies in Bay Area cities, including San Francisco, a group of community leaders Created "United Against Hate Week" as a way to make a statement that neo-Nazis, their hatred and their ideas were not welcome in the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco seeks to join other cities around the Bay Area including Berkeley, Oakland and Fremont in recognizing United Against Hate Week as an important step in bridging divisions as well as strengthening our communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors hereby declares the week of November 17 to November 23, 2019, as "United Against Hate Week."
