1 AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN
 2 FRANCISCO TO ~~RETROACTIVELY~~ APPLY FOR, AND , RETROACTIVELY,
 3 FUNDS NOT TO EXCEED THE AMOUNT OF \$140,000 AVAILABLE THROUGH THE
 4 CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE PLANNING FOR A PROJECT
 5 ENTITLED "THREAT MANAGEMENT/STALKING VERTICAL PROSECUTION" FOR
 6 THE TWELVE MONTH PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 1999 THROUGH AUGUST 31,
 7 2000, AND WAIVING INDIRECT COST DUE TO FUNDING CONSTRAINTS.

8 WHEREAS, The District Attorney and the City and County of
 9 San Francisco desires to undertake a project designated the
 10 Threat Management/Stalking Vertical Prosecution Program to be
 11 funded in part from funds made available through the California
 12 Penal Code Section 13837 and 13813 administered by the California
 13 Office of Criminal Justice Planning (OCJP); and
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15 WHEREAS, this project will investigate and vertically
 16 prosecute cases of stalking against women, their children or
 17 other family members; now,

18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of the
 19 City and County of San Francisco is authorized retroactively, on
 20 its behalf to submit the attached proposal to OCJP, and is
 21 authorized to sign and approve on behalf of the City and County
 22 of San Francisco the attached Grant Award Agreement including any
 23 extensions or amendments thereof except as any amendment would
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1 increase any hard matching fund obligation of the City and
2 County of San Francisco pursuant to the contract; and

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the applicant agrees to provide
4 all matching funds required for said project under the program and
5 the funding terms and conditions of OCJP and that the in-kind match
6 will be appropriated as required; and


7 BE IT FURTHER REVOLVED, that is agreed that any liability
8 arising out of the performance of this Grant Award Agreement,
9 including civil court actions for damages, shall be the
10 responsibility of the grantee and the authorizing agency. The State
11 of California and the Office of Criminal Justice Planning disclaim
12 responsibility for any such liability; and

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that grant funds received hereunder
15 shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

16 THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the District Attorney of
17 the City and County of San Francisco is authorized to ~~retroactively~~
18 and , retroactively,
19 apply for/ accept/and expend funds made available through the Office
20 of Criminal Justice Planning for a project entitled "Threat
21 management/Stalking Vertical Prosecution" in the amount of \$140,000
22 for the twelve month period September 1, 1999 through August 31,
23 2000, and waiving indirect cost due to funding constraints; and

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the three new positions
25 authorized under the grant shall be designated as "G" or "Grant-
funded"positions, which would terminate when the grant expires.

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
