

1 [Research on club-drug networks among high-risk men.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health, AIDS Office**  
4 **(SFDPHAIDS) to accept retroactively and expend a supplemental grant award in the**  
5 **amount of \$37,011 from the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA) for research on**  
6 **club-drug networks among high-risk men and to enter into an agreement for the use of**  
7 **these funds; for the period of March 1, 2003 to February 29, 2004.**

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9 WHEREAS, SFDPHAIDS was awarded a grant from NIDA in the amount of \$159,973  
10 for research on club-drugs and HIV risk behavior in high-risk men; and,

11 WHEREAS, SFDPHAIDS was authorized by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors  
12 to accept retroactively and expend this grant under Resolution No. 342-03; and,

13 WHEREAS, SFDPHAIDS has received a supplemental grant award in the amount of  
14 \$37,011 for research on club-drug networks among high-risk men; and,

15 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the supplemental grant funds, NIDA requires  
16 the City to enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk  
17 of the Board of Supervisors in File No. \_\_\_\_\_, which is hereby declared to be a  
18 part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

19 WHEREAS, The supplemental grant budget includes provision for indirect costs of  
20 \$2,742; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That SFDPHAIDS is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and  
22 expend a supplemental grant in the amount of \$37,011 from NIDA; and, be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPHAIDS is hereby authorized to accept and expend  
24 the supplemental grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the agreement  
25 pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the  
2 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the positions  
4 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when  
5 the agreement expires.
