3	Resolution approving the Controller's Certification that Airport Information Booth
4	Services at San Francisco International Airport can practically be performed by private
5	contractor at a lower cost than if work were performed by City employees at currently
6	budgeted.

8	WHEREAS, The electorate of the City and County of San Francisco adopted a new
9	charter effective July 1, 1996 which in Section 10.104(15) incorporates the provisions of
10	Proposition "J" adopted November 1976, allowing City Departments to contract with private
11	companies for specific services; and,
12	WHEREAS, The Controller has certified on May 27, 2003, that the services involved in
13	the management and operation of an Airport Information Booth Program at San Francisco
14	International Airport can be practically performed by Polaris Research and Development at a
15	lower cost to the City and County of San Francisco than if such services were performed by
16	employees of the City and County of San Francisco; and
17	WHEREAS, On June 3, 2003, pursuant to Resolution No. 03-0113, the Airport
18	Commission awarded the Airport Information Booth to Polaris/TRG Joint Venture; now,
19	therefore, be it
20	RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.104(15) of the Charter, this Board of
21	Supervisors hereby approves said Controller's Certification.
