

1 [Contract Modification - S & S Trucking Corporation - Estimated Cumulative Value of
2 \$13,500,000]

3 **Resolution extending an agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and**
4 **S & S Trucking Corporation from December 20, 2013, through December 19, 2015, and**
5 **increasing the estimated cumulative contract amount from \$9,000,000 to \$13,500,000**
6 **for hauling biosolids (sludge) and grit, pursuant to Charter, Section 9.118(b).**

8 WHEREAS, The Wastewater Enterprise of the San Francisco Public Utilities
9 Commission (SFPUC) wastewater treatment facilities produce approximately 80,000 wet tons
10 per year of Class B biosolids and 4,000 wet tons per year of grit that must be hauled to
11 various out-of-county locations for beneficial land application on a daily basis; and,

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Office of Contract Administration (OCA) issued
13 Contract Proposal 68380 to solicit competitive bids for biosolids and grit hauling services for
14 the SFPUC; and

15 WHEREAS, Bids were received and evaluated by the OCA, and S & S Trucking
16 Corporation was determined to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

17 WHEREAS, The OCA awarded a five-year contract with the provision for two two-year
18 extensions to S & S Trucking Corporation for hauling services effective December 20, 2008;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, A copy of the approved contract is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
21 Supervisors in File No. 130962, which is hereby declared to be a part of this Resolution as if
22 fully set forth herein; and

23 WHEREAS, The five year contract with S & S Trucking Corporation is scheduled to
24 expire on December 19, 2013 unless a two-year extension is approved; and

1 WHEREAS, The service rendered by S&S Trucking Corporation has been consistently
2 reliable and satisfactory; and

3 WHEREAS, Approval of a two-year extension results in an increase in the total price by
4 approximately \$2,000,000 per year to accommodate the expense incurred during the first two-
5 year extension period, resulting in an anticipated cumulative contract cost of \$13.5 million;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, At this time the SFPUC does not intend to exercise the second two-year
8 contract extension option with S & S Trucking Corporation but intends to develop and
9 competitively bid a new contract for biosolids hauling; and

10 WHEREAS, Charter Section 9.118(b) requires Board of Supervisor authorization, by
11 resolution, of contracts with a value in excess of \$10,000,000; now, therefore, be it

12 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Office of Contract
13 Administration to exercise the option and execute a two year extension of the contract for
14 Biosolids and Grit Hauling Services between the City and County of San Francisco and S & S
15 Trucking Corporation; and, be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the contract option to extend the
17 term by two years being fully executed by all parties the General Manager of the San
18 Francisco Public Utilities Commission shall provide the final contract modification to the Clerk
19 of the Board for inclusion in the official file.
