3 **Resolution commending the Public Utilities Commission and the OMI/Excelsior Beacon**
4 **Center for helping San Francisco residents reduce their water bills by selling high**
5 **quality, 1.6 Gallons Per Flush Toilets for only \$10 on Saturday, April 5 from 8 a.m. to 1**
6 **p.m. at the Crocker-Amazon Park, Moscow and Geneva.**

8 WHEREAS, The City of San Francisco and its Public Utilities Commission are
9 committed to water conservation; and

10 WHEREAS, Use of toilets accounts for 40% of the water used in an average home in
11 San Francisco; and,

12 WHEREAS, Replacing water-inefficient toilets with water-efficient toilets in an average
13 residential dwelling saves 21 gallons per day in a single-family home and 35 gallons of water
14 per day in an apartment; and,

15 WHEREAS, This allows the average family in San Francisco to save \$90 annually on
16 their water bill; and,

17 WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission has created partnerships with community
18 organizations over the last five years to replace 34,000 toilets throughout San Francisco; and,

19 WHEREAS, The Public Utilities Commission will be working with OMI/Excelsior
20 Beacon Center to sell high quality, brand-new 1.6 gallons per flush toilets for only \$10 on
21 Saturday, April 5 at the Crocker-Amazon Recreation Center, Moscow and France from 8 a.m.
22 to 1 p.m.; and,
