13	Health Continuum Infrastructure Program (Bond BHCIP) Round 2 Unmet Needs Program
14	("Program"), pursuant to the Behavioral Health Infrastructure Bond Act of 2024; and
15	WHEREAS, Program funding allocations are subject to the terms and conditions of the
16	Requests for Applications, the Application, Program Funding Agreement, and all other legal
17	requirements of the Program; and
18	WHEREAS, DHCS requires that the governing body of the applicant jurisdiction
19	formally pre-authorize the City to (1) submit applications for Grant funds; (2) accept Grant
20	funds if the City's Grant Applications are approved, with the understanding that all Grant funds
21	must be used for the allowable expenditures and activities identified in the Grant Agreement,
22	and (3) agree to all Grant terms, including binding arbitration and/or a waiver of claims agains
23	DHCS and its third-party Grant Administrator; now therefore, be it

9	FURTHER RESOLVED, That if one or more Applications are approved, SFDPH shall
10	obtain authorization by resolution of the Board of Supervisors to accept and expend the
11	grant(s) and enter into the Program Funding Agreements for the total award amount, subject
12	to all Program Funding Agreement terms, including binding arbitration and/or a waiver of
13	claims against DHCS and its third-party Grant Administrator.
