11	WHEREAS, Non-union janitors are among the most seriously affected by the national
12	healthcare crisis and local cities must carry the burden of these healthcare costs; and,
13	WHEREAS, Union janitors feel more secure in their positions and are able to carry out
14 15	their work with dignity and pride; and,
16	WHEREAS, Non-union janitors have no job protections or job security; and
17	WHEREAS, Union janitors have a voice on the job and are able to advocate for
18	themselves and their families; and,
19	WHEREAS, Union janitors have the guaranteed protections of a union contract; and,
20	WHEREAS, Union janitors have lower turn-over and higher seniority rates within their
21	profession; now, therefore be it
22	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
2324	urge UCSF to make janitorial custodians in-house employees; and be it
