WHEREAS, Assemblyman Wally Knox sponsored AB 208, which would require life imprisonment without the possibility of parole for defendants convicted of first-degree murder if the victim was intentionally killed because of his or her actual or perceived disability, gender or sexual orientation; and,

WHEREAS, Assemblyman Antonio Villaraigosa crafted AB 1001, which would outlaw discrimination on the basis of sexual orientation in housing and employment; and,

WHEREAS, These landmark bills were approved by both houses of the state legislature and recently signed into law by Governor Gray Davis; and,
