RE: Recommendation of Mr. Chris Jerdonek for appointment to the San Francisco Elections Commission Rules Committee March 20, 2014

Dear Supervisors,

For the past ten years I served as the Board of Supervisors' appointee to the Elections Commission in the seat vacated that you are now reviewing applicants for. I viewed my service on the Elections Commission as a trust placed in me by the Board and made a serious commitment to fulfill the Charter's mandate for the Commission which is oversight of the Department of Elections to conduct free, fair and functional elections. In the ten years, 2004 to 2013, I missed only 2 of the over 130 regular, special and committee meetings, served two terms as Commission President, and all years I was not Commission President, I was a member of the Commission's only standing committee, Budget and Oversight of Public Elections, most years as Chair of that Committee. In addition, I served as an Election Day pollworker for 14 of the 16 public elections which occurred during my term. Prior to service on the Elections Commission, I worked for a time at the Department of Elections as the person responsible for ballot design and production of the Voter Information Pamphlet — a key position within the Department. Given my service and background with elections administration in San Francisco, I would appreciate your consideration of my recommendation for filling the vacant seat.

Mr. Chris Jerdonek is someone who I have known since 2005 and is one of the few people in San Francisco who clearly demonstrates that he understands and cares deeply about elections administration and the conduct of elections. Frankly, few members of the public attend Elections Commission meetings. Mr. Jerdonek is one of those few.

Mr. Jerdonek has served numerous times as an Election Day pollworker; observed the post-election canvas for certification of the votes; and reviewed vote count data for anomalies. He has provided me, the Commission, the Department and the public with detailed observations of election conduct and data. I recall that he was the person who pointed out that the Department was not following proper protocol for selection of random precincts chosen for the post-election manual tally... Mr. Jerdonek pointed out that the Department was selecting and making the random precincts publicly known before the election... thus invalidating any randomness. Such an error can bring doubt upon any election. Mr. Jerdonek caught what to some may seem to be a minor detail... but as the saying goes, the devil is in the details. Just one example of Mr. Jerdonek's attention to and knowledge of elections administration.

Given Mr. Jerdonek's background in mathematics, understanding of elections administration, that he is one of the few people who has attended and given feedback at Elections Commission meetings, that I would also encounter him at Saturday morning pollworker trainings before elections... I believe Mr. Jerdonek is the very best qualified person to serve on the Elections Commission.

Currently the Department of Elections has excellent management and operations under Director John Arntz. But that does not mean there should be an absence of oversight. In fact, the Director of Elections is in one of the very few department heads within City & County government who exists without ultimate accountability to the elected executive management of the City... or to the voters. Therefore the Elections Commission is tasked with a very serious mandate of oversight. The qualifications to do that are considerable. The seat on the Elections Commission is not a résumé builder. It is a serious, committed trust.

The current members of the Elections Commission are citizens who take the commitment seriously. Unfortunately, none, with the exception of current member Richard Matthews, bring prior elections administration experience and knowledge to the Commission... and Commissioner Matthews' term ends this year. Therefore it would be extremely helpful to the Commission to have someone with Mr. Jerdonek's background and expertise appointed at this time.

The last point I would like to make is to caution against appointing anyone to the Commission whose knowledge of elections is from the electoral campaign side of elections. There is a considerable difference between election campaigns and elections administration. In fact, San Francisco's Department of Elections suffered for many years from that conflict. That dichotomy no longer exists within the culture of the Elections Department and the Elections Commission and it should remain so. The mandate for the Elections Commission rests with the conduct of and *not* the outcome of elections.

I greatly appreciate your consideration of my recommendation of Mr. Jerdonek for the seat on the Elections Commission. It was a pleasure to have been able to serve on the Elections Commission and I am grateful to the Board of Supervisors for allowing me the honor.

Dear Supervisors Norman Yee, Katy Tang and David Campos,

As a longtime resident of San Francisco, I am writing to ask you to support the appointment of Mr. Chris Jerdonek to the SF Elections Commission.

It can be difficult to find good people to fill these vacancies, especially for a commission like the Elections Commission which is not usually in the public limelight and is very nuts and bolts oriented. Board Qualifications:

The Elections Commission consists of seven members, one of whom is appointed by the Board of Supervisors and is broadly representative of the general public. The composition of the other members are as follows: one member appointed by the Mayor; the City Attorney, the Public Defender, the District Attorney, the Treasurer, and the Board of Education of the San Francisco Unified School District. The member appointed by the Mayor shall have a background in the electoral process. The member appointed by the City Attorney shall have a background in elections law. The member appointed by the Treasurer shall have a background in financial management. The members appointed by the District Attorney, Public Defender, the Board of Education of SFUSD shall be broadly representative of the general public.

Term of Office: The Commission members shall serve five-year terms. No person appointed as a Commission member may serve as such for more than two successive five-year terms. Any person appointed as a commission member to complete more than two and one half years of a five-year term shall be deemed to have served one full term. In the event a vacancy occurs, the appointing authority who appointed the member vacating the office shall appoint a qualified person to complete the remainder of the term. All members initially appointed shall take office on January 1, 2002.

The Elections Commission shall oversee all public federal, state, district and municipal elections in the City and County. The Commission shall set general policies for the Department of Elections and shall be responsible for the proper administration of the general practices of the

Department, subject to the budgetary and fiscal provision of the Charter. These duties shall include but not be limited to approving written plans prior to each election, submitted by the Director of Elections, detailing the policies, procedures, and personnel that will be used to conduct the election as well as an assessment of how well the plan succeeded in carrying out a free, fair and functional election. See Charter for restrictions on membership.
