I live in western SOMA and have witnessed the good work of SOMA West Community Benefit District (CBD)'s safety ambassador program. The Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing (HSH) began funding these CBD safety ambassadors in HSH's effort to be good neighbors. Since the program began in 2015, these ambassadors have conducted 2,217 welfare checks, responded to 2,448 instances of loitering, and made 483 encampment contacts.

I urge you to vote in favor of HSH's request to release their reserve funding so that this successful program can be increased and expanded as part of the City's implementation of its official Good Neighbor Policy.
