WHEREAS, On December 13, 1999, the Board of Supervisors adopted by unanimous vote Resolution #1127-99, creating a sustainable funding for school arts and music task force to make policy recommendations to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco; and,

WHEREAS, This task force is comprised of 20 members, 13 of whom are designated and 7 of whom are at-large representatives; and, WHEREAS, These 20 members include:

- one (1) member who shall be the Director of the Department of Children, Youth, and Families or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the Director of the Art Commission or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the President of the San Francisco Parent Teacher Association or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the San Francisco Special Projects Officer of the California State Parent Teacher Association or his/her designated representative,

- one (1) member who shall be the designated representative of the San Francisco Unified School Board,
- one (1) member who shall be the Arts Administrator of the San Francisco Unified School District or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the President of the United Educators of San Francisco or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the Executive Director of the Arts Providers Alliance of San Francisco or his/her designated representative,
- one (1) member who shall be the designated representative of the Arts Education Funders' Collaborative,
- one (1) member who shall be the designated representative of the Small Business Commission,
- one (1) member who shall be the designated representative of the Chamber of Commerce,
- one (1) member who shall be the designated representative of the Youth Commission,
- one (1) member who shall be the designated liaison to the Board of Supervisors,
- one (1) at-large member who shall be a student in the San Francisco Unified School District,
- one (1) at-large member who shall be a parent of a student in the San Francisco Unified School District,

- one (1) at-large member who shall be a teacher in the San Francisco Unified School District,
- one (1) at-large member representing the interests of the business community,
- one (1) at-large member representing the interests of the philanthropic community,
- one (1) at-large member representing a youth advocacy organization,
- one (1) at-large member representing an arts advocacy organization; and,

WHEREAS, These members are charged with making recommendations to the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors regarding a sustainable funding source for school arts and music programs as well as recommendations on a fiscal body to monitor and distribute funding for school arts and music programs; and,

WHEREAS, Great interest was shown in serving on the at-large seats of the task force, particularly from teachers and members of arts advocacy organization; now therefore be it,

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco hereby adds two seats to the sustainable funding for school arts and music task force: an at-large seat who shall be a teacher in the San Francisco Unified School District and an at-large seat who shall be a member of an arts advocacy organization.
