

1 [Showers at Lowell High School.]

3 **Resolution urging the San Francisco Unified School District to consult with, and obtain**  
4 **the approval of, the Crestlake Property Owners Association, the Lakeshore Acres**  
5 **Improvement Club, the Lakeside Homes Association, the Lakeside Property Owner’s**  
6 **Association, the Merced Manor Property Owner’s Association, the West of Twin Peaks**  
7 **Central Council, and the District Seven Advisory Council before implementing a plan to**  
8 **allow homeless individuals to use shower facilities at Lowell High School.**

10 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Education recently voted unanimously to  
11 extend the shower program for homeless individuals at Mission High School for another year;  
12 and,

13 WHEREAS, The Mission High School shower program has caused concern among  
14 neighbors in the Mission High School area; and

15 WHEREAS, One School Board member, Dr. Dan Kelly, has suggested that the shower  
16 program for homeless individuals be extended to other San Francisco Unified School District  
17 facilities, including Lowell High School; and,

18 WHEREAS, In order to ensure that such a program would be welcome in the Lowell  
19 High School neighborhood, and in order to avoid the neighborhood problems experienced by  
20 the Mission High School neighbors, the School Board should consult with the homeowner  
21 associations in the Lowell High school neighborhood; now, therefore, be it

22 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
23 urges the San Francisco Unified School District to consult with, and obtain the approval of,  
24 the Crestlake Property Owners Association, the Lakeshore Acres Improvement Club, the  
25 Lakeside Homes Association, the Lakeside Property Owner’s Association, the Merced Manor

1 Property Owner's Association, the West of Twin Peaks Central Council, and the District  
2 Seven Advisory Council before implementing a plan to allow homeless individuals to use  
3 shower facilities at Lowell High School; and, be it

4 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges the San Francisco  
5 Unified School District to provide representatives of each of the above named associations at  
6 least two weeks written notice of any public meetings at which expansion of the shower  
7 program will be discussed, as well as notice of any steps taken by the School Board towards  
8 implementation of the program or steps taken not to implement the program; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board  
10 of Supervisors to send a copy of this resolution to the Executive Assistant to the Board of  
11 Education.
