1	[Ordinance providing that a Member may not consecutively serve for more than two four-year
2	terms on the Redevelopment Agency Board; this changes the current Administrative Code provisions, which do not provide a term limit.]

4	Ordinance amending Administrative Code Section 24.4-1 to provide that a Member may
5	not consecutively serve for more than two four-year terms on the Redevelopment
6	Agency Board, and that a Member shall be deemed to have served one full term if the
7	Member serves 24 months or more of an uncompleted term or if the Member resigns
8	after serving 24 months or more of a term; this changes the current Administrative
9	Code provisions, which do not provide a term limit.

15	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

17	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by amending
18	Section 24.1-1, to read as follows:
19	SEC. 24.1-1. INCREASING NUMBER OF MEMBERS TO BE APPOINTED TO
20	REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, <i>LIMITATION OF TERMS</i> .
21	(a) Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 24.1 of this Chapter, and pursuant to
22	the provisions of Section 33110 of the Health and Safety Code of the State of California, the
23	number of members to be appointed to the Redevelopment Agency of the City and County of
24	San Francisco is hereby increased to seven, one of whom shall be a woman.

1	(b) No Member may serve for more than two successive four-year terms. Any person
2	appointed and serving 24 months or more of an uncompleted term, or who resigns after serving 24
3	months or more of a term, shall be deemed for the purpose of this section to have served one full term.
4	No person who has served two successive four-terms may be appointed again as a Member until at
5	least four years after the expiration of the second successive term in office.
