

1 [SETTLEMENT OF CLAIM]

3 **Resolution approving settlement of claim by City and County of San Francisco against**
4 **Cambridge Integrated Services, Inc., for claimed errors and omissions by Cambridge in**
5 **administering the workers' compensation claim of City employee Fanny Tang.**

7 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco ("City") entered a contract with
8 Cambridge Integrated Services, Inc. ("Cambridge"), to serve as the third-party administrator
9 for the City in relation to workers' compensation claims submitted by City employees; and

10 WHEREAS, City employee Fanny Tang submitted a workers' compensation claim in
11 June 1997, which resulted in a December 2001 award by the Workers' Compensation
12 Appeals Board in favor of Ms. Tang entitling her to certain workers' compensation benefits;
13 and

14 WHEREAS, The City claimed that Cambridge failed to take all appropriate actions to
15 administer Ms. Tang's claim, and that Ms. Tang would have received a smaller permanent
16 disability award absent errors and omissions by Cambridge; and

17 WHEREAS, The City and Cambridge agreed that Cambridge would pay the City One
18 Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) to resolve and release the City's claim
19 against Cambridge; and

20 WHEREAS, The settlement agreement between the City and Cambridge, which is on
21 file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. _____, is hereby declared to be a part
22 of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and

23 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Resources recommends that the City settle its
24 claim by payment to the City by Cambridge of One Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars
25 (\$120,000); and

1 WHEREAS, now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That pursuant to Section 10.24(b) of the San Francisco Administrative
3 Code, settlement and release of the City's claims against Cambridge, by payment of One
4 Hundred and Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$120,000) to the City by Cambridge, be and is
5 approved.
