WHEREAS, On January 26, 2001 a 7.9 earthquake hit the Indian subcontinent, the worst earthquake in recent history; and,

WHEREAS, The Gujarat earthquake has devastated the capital city of Gujarat and the town of Ahmedabad, as well as neighboring towns and neighboring states; and,

WHEREAS, According to latest reports, tens of thousands lives have been lost, and many structures, including hospitals, schools and places of worship have been damaged and leveled; and,

WHEREAS, Many residents of the Bay Area and San Francisco have family, friends and other loved ones who have been severely impacted by the earthquake; and,

WHEREAS, Several relief efforts and funds have been established, including the Indo-American trade and Commerce Council's Gujarat Earthquake Relief Fund where a tax deductible donation can be made; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby extends its condolences and greatest sympathy tot he people of India and those affected by the Gujarat earthquake; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco urges its citizens to donate resources and assistance to relief efforts established for India as a result of this natural disaster.


