

1 [Appointments, Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area Citizen’s Advisory Committee–
2 Bryant Duong, Stephen Tennis, Sam Dennison, and Jonathan Bonato]

3 **Motion appointing Bryant Duong (residency requirement waived) and Stephen Tennis,**
4 **terms ending November 2, 2019, and Sam Dennison and Jonathan Bonato, terms**
5 **ending January 31, 2021, to the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area Citizen's**
6 **Advisory Committee.**

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8 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
9 hereby appoint the hereinafter designated persons to serve as members of the Central Market
10 Street and Tenderloin Area Citizen’s Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions in the
11 Business and Tax Regulations Code, Article 12-A, for the terms specified:

12 Bradford Paul (residency requirement waived), seat 5, succeeding himself, term
13 expired, must have expertise in affordable housing or tenant protection and anti-displacement
14 policies and strategies, and have familiarity with the Central Market Street and Tenderloin
15 Area, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending August 2, 2019;

16 Sam Dennison, seat 1, new appointment, must be held either by a person with
17 expertise in job creation or workforce development, or by a person who is a resident of the
18 Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area, for the unexpired portion of a
19 four-year term ending January 31, 2021;

20 Bryant Duong (residency requirement waived), seat 2, new appointment, must be held
21 either by a person who represents a community-based organization or provides direct
22 services to the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area, or by a person
23 who is a resident of the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area, for the
24 unexpired portion of a four-year term ending November 2, 2019;

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1 Jonathan Bonato seat 3, new appointment must shall be held either by a person with
2 expertise on homelessness, transitional age youth, or supportive housing, and familiarity with
3 the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area, or by a person who is a
4 resident of the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area, for the unexpired
5 portion of a four-year term ending January 31, 2021;

6 Stephen Tennis, seat 4, new appointment, must be held by a resident of the Central
7 Market Street and Tenderloin Area or adjacent area with expertise or life experience involving
8 homelessness or affordable housing, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending
9 November 2, 2019; and, be it

10 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 11 1. The membership of the Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area Citizen's
12 Advisory Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of the City and
13 County of San Francisco.
- 14 2. Applicant Bryant Duong, who is not a resident of San Francisco, is a person with
15 experience that uniquely qualifies him to serve on the Central Market Street and
16 Tenderloin Area Citizen's Advisory Committee.
- 17 3. The Central Market Street and Tenderloin Area Citizen's Advisory Committee has
18 attempted to fill the position, for which Bryant Doung was nominated, with an
19 individual who is a City resident and who has the specific experience, skills, and
20 qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee has
21 certified that Bryant Doung is qualified to serve on the Central Market Street and
22 Tenderloin Area Citizen's Advisory Committee.
- 23 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
24 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco, and who has the
25 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is

1 willing to serve on the Citizen’s Advisory Committee for the Central Market Street
2 and Tenderloin Area at this time; and, be it

3 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency requirement
4 for Bryant Duong, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing to serve, can
5 be found, pursuant to Charter, Section 4.101(a)(2), that requires person(s) appointed to
6 boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the Board of
7 Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.

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
