



In my capacity as executive director, I oversee the administration of our housing programs in two historic SRO's: The Mary Elizabeth Inn (The Inn), a 92-unit facility in district 3; and the Hotel Verona, a 65-unit facility in district 6. The Inn opened its doors in 1914, providing a safe and affordable, home-away-from home for women seeking new beginnings in San Francisco. MEI recognized the growing need for affordable and safe housing for San Francisco's female homeless population and we began developing and implementing programs targeting this growing population. In 1996, MEI secured funding from the Department on the Status of Women (DOSW) to implement the INNroads housing program, which provides permanent

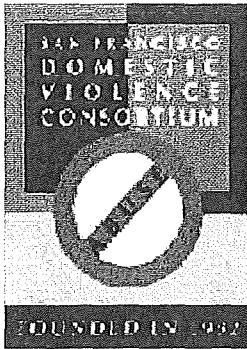



22 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
23 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
24 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

1 Section 3. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
2 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
3 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
4 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
5 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
6 the official title of the ordinance.
