RE: File 220750 – Initiative Ordinance – Golden Gate Park Access and Safety Program

Dear Ms. Calvillo,

Should the proposed Initiative Ordinance be approved by the voters, in my opinion, there would be no additional costs to government. However, there may be significant future costs associated with needed capital projects to support the Golden Gate Park Access and Safety Program.

The Ordinance will amend the Park Code to repeal and reauthorize the Golden Gate Park Access and Safety Program, which establishes new recreation and open space by limiting private vehicles on certain street segments of Golden Gate Park including on JFK Drive, making certain street segments one-way, establishing bicycle lanes, and urging additional changes to improve public access to Golden Gate Park. Future capital improvements may include the addition of ADA parking, curb ramps and path of travel upgrades, transportation improvements, and other transit improvements.

Any additional capital improvement costs associated with this Ordinance would be determined by the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors through the normal budget process.
