3 **Resolution declaring April 2002, IHSS Public Authority Awareness and Registration**
4 **for Services of Latino Consumers and Worker Opportunities Month**

7 WHEREAS, One-fifth of all Americans nationwide face some type of disability; and

10 WHEREAS, Of the over 100,000 Latinos living in San Francisco, more than 22,000
11 are experiencing some type of disability; and

14 WHEREAS, San Francisco's Latino residents like others with disabilities are an
15 important and integral part of our community, in particular in District 9 the Inner Mission and
16 District 11 the Outer Mission, and are making a significant contribution to the growth and
17 progress of this City; and

20 WHEREAS, The Latino community in many cases, because of language and cultural
21 barriers, is not aware of the services offered by IHSS Public Authority In-Home Care
22 Supportive Services that are available; and

25 WHEREAS, The IHSS Public Authority has a Viable Model for Self-Directed
Personal Assistance Services featuring the independent mode of services; and

28 WHEREAS, In-Home Supportive Services is a state-wide public program paying
29 Home care workers for tasks that make it possible for people with disabling conditions to
30 live safely in their homes; and

33 WHEREAS, IHSS now provides services hours each month to about 10,000 San
34 Franciscans with functional impairments; and

1 WHEREAS, The IHSS Public Authority wants to become more accessible to both
2 Latino consumers and workers in District 9 the Inner Mission and District 11 the Outer
3 Mission; and

4 WHEREAS, The IHSS Public Authority is developing a Latino Community Outreach
5 Collaboration with community-based agencies who serve the predominantly Latino
6 community in the Inner and Outer Mission; and

7 WHEREAS, The IHSS Public Authority and the Latino Community Outreach
8 Collaboration will implement a major awareness and registration campaign to address
9 better inclusion of Latino workers and disabled consumers and workers in IHSS and its
10 services; NOW THEREFORE, BE IT

11 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco,
12 Joined by the IHSS Public Authority proclaims the month of April 2002, as the IHSS Public
13 Authority Awareness and Registration for Services of Latino Consumers and Worker
14 Opportunities Month.
