

1 [Contract funds to participate in the development of a national violent death reporting system.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **enter retroactively into an agreement with the California Department of Health Services**
5 **(CDHS), the primary contractor, and expend funds in the amount of up to \$70,000 in**
6 **order to participate in the development of a national violent death reporting system,**
7 **and to add one 0.5 position funded under this agreement; for the period of January 1,**
8 **2005, through September 29, 2009.**

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10 WHEREAS, CDHS is the recipient of a grant award from the federal Centers for
11 Disease Control and Prevention (CDCP) to develop a National Violent Death Reporting
12 System; and,

13 WHEREAS, CDHS and SFDPH have agreed to enter into a subcontract agreement to
14 participate in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, CDHS has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of up to \$70,000
16 from this award under the terms of this subcontract agreement; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds, CDHS requires SFDPH to enter
18 into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
20 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, The subcontract agreement budget includes provision for indirect costs of
22 \$5,500; and,

23 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
24 because we did not receive the subcontract agreement until April 5, 2005; and,

1 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
 2 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
 3 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
 4 of grant funding; and,

5 WHEREAS, One 0.5 as needed position will be added through this agreement; now,
 6 therefore, be it

7 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
 8 agreement in the amount of up to \$70,000 with CDHS, the primary contractor; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
 10 agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate the position funded
 12 under this agreement as a "G" or grant-funded position which would terminate when the
 13 agreement expires.
