The Department of Public Health (DPH) will request approval for one (1) retroactive item at the June 15th Special Budget & Appropriations Committee meeting. We've provided a brief description of the item and our DPH representatives. Please let us know if you have any questions.

Agenda item #11 – File 230679 - Agreement - Retroactive - Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. - Mobile Crisis Services - Anticipated Revenue to the City of \$1,977,500 - Resolution retroactively approving an agreement, for a term of September 15, 2021, through June 30, 2025, between the San Francisco Department of Public Health and Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. having anticipated revenue to the City of \$1,977,500; and to authorize the Department of Public Health to enter into amendments or modifications to the agreement prior to its final execution by all parties that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of the agreement or this Resolution.

- **Description:** This agreement before the Committee would approve DPH acceptance of nonstandard terms and conditions in a grant agreement between DPH and Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP). The California Department of Health Care Services selected AHP to manage funding for the Behavioral Health Continuum Program. AHP, in their role as managing Behavioral health Continuum Program funding, awarded DPH with grant funding in the amount of \$1,977,500, to provide Comprehensive Crisis Services (CCS).
- **Reason for Retroactive Request:** On April 12th, 2022, the Board of Supervisors approved this grant through the accept and expend process (file [220202](#)). In June of 2022, after the accept and expend grant was approved, the City Attorney's Office reviewed the agreement associated with this grant which includes nonstandard terms and conditions requiring Board Approval. The agreement before the Committee would approve DPH acceptance of these nonstandard terms and conditions, retroactive to the grant term start date, September 15th, 2021.
