13	largest almond processing facility in the world and the Blue Diamond brand is a well known
14	retail product that is a major sponsor of professional sporting events including the San
15	Francisco 49ers; and,
16	WHEREAS, Blue Diamond Growers exports 70% of its almonds to world markets and
17	relies heavily on its positive brand name identification; and,
18	WHEREAS, Blue Diamond has chosen to respond to the efforts of its employees to joi
19	the International Longshore and Warehouse Union (ILWU) with an "aggressive union
20	avoidance campaign" and the National Labor Relations Board has issued 28 separate
21	complaints against Blue Diamond for violations of federal labor laws; and,
22	WHEREAS, the ILWU is one of California and San Francisco's most respected unions
23	with traditions of rank and file democracy that are unparalleled; now, therefore, be it

2	supports the workers of Blue Diamond Growers in their efforts to join the ILWU; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors condemns Blue Diamond for
4	waging an aggressive anti-union campaign and violating the National Labor Relations Act;

6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors calls on Blue Diamond to enter
7	into a neutrality agreement with the ILWU and allow the workers of Blue Diamond Growers to
8	make a decision about unionization through a card check procedure.
