

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Reentry Council - Eligibility Age Change]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to change the eligibility age for one of the seven former inmate members appointed to the Reentry Council by the Mayor from ages 18 to 24 to ages 18 to 35, and to require that that inmate member have been an inmate before the age of 24.

Existing Law

Under current law, the Reentry Council consist of 24 members, seven of whom must be former inmates. The Mayor appoints three of these seven members. Of these three members, at least one must be between the ages of 18 to 24 at the time of appointment.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance changes the eligibility age for one of the seven former inmate members from ages 18 to 24 to ages 18 to 35, and requires that that inmate member have been an inmate before the age of 24.
