11 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

12

13 Section 1. Findings. The Planning Department has determined that the actions
14 contemplated in this ordinance comply with the California Environmental Quality Act
15 (California Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.). Said determination is on file with
16 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. ___ and is incorporated herein by reference.

18 Section 2. The Park Code is hereby amended by revising Section 12.12.1, to read as
19 follows:

20 **SEC. 12.12.1. HARDING PARK GOLF COURSE.**

21 (a) Greens Fees.

11 Notwithstanding the greens fees specified in the chart above, during the greens renovation
12 period (the period from December 2, 2013 through either May 31, 2014 or the date of completion of the
13 2013-14 greens renovation as certified in writing by the General Manager, whichever occurs earlier),
14 the greens fees set forth in the chart below shall apply. At the end of the greens renovation period, this
15 paragraph and the chart below shall expire by operation of law, and the City Attorney shall cause this
16 paragraph and the chart below to be removed from the Park Code.

8 (b) Replay Rate. A same-day replay rate is available to golfers who complete an 18-
9 hole round for the following fee categories only: Standard, Bay Area and Resident. The
10 replay rate shall be 30 percent of the originally purchased round. The replay round must be
11 used by the purchaser of the full price round. Replay rounds may not be reserved in advance.

12 (c) Reservation Premiums. A \$10.00 per person fee shall be charged for advance tee
13 times scheduled eight days or more in advance of the tee time.

14 (d) Practice Range. The following fees shall be charged for a bucket of balls for use at
15 the Driving Range:

16	Small bucket (25-30 balls)	\$7.00
17	Medium bucket (45-50 balls)	\$9.00
18	Large bucket (70-75 balls)	\$12.00

19 (e) Shotgun Tournament (120 players or more). The following fees shall apply in
20 addition to the regular Tournament Rate:

21 (1) Weekday Shotgun (per player) - \$10.00

22 (2) Weekend Shotgun (per player) - \$15.00

23 (f) Accompanying Rider Rate. The fee for non-golfers riding in a motorized cart shall
24 be \$25.00 per person.

1 Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
2 enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
3 ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
4 of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.

5
6 Section 4. Scope of Ordinance. In enacting this ordinance, the Board of Supervisors
7 intends to amend only those words, phrases, paragraphs, subsections, sections, articles,
8 numbers, punctuation marks, charts, diagrams, or any other constituent parts of the Municipal
9 Code that are explicitly shown in this ordinance as additions, deletions, Board amendment
10 additions, and Board amendment deletions in accordance with the "Note" that appears under
11 the official title of the ordinance.

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LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Park Code - Harding Park Golf Course Temporary Reduced Greens Fees]

Ordinance amending the Park Code to set temporary reduced greens fees for the Harding Park Golf Course from December 2, 2013, through no later than May 31, 2014, to accommodate the renovation of the greens; and making environmental findings.

Existing Law

Section 12.12.1(a) of the Park Code sets greens fees for Harding Park Golf Course.

Amendments to Current Law

The ordinance would amend Section 12.12.1(a) of the Park Code to set temporary reduced greens fees for the Harding Park Golf Course during the greens renovation period (the period from December 2, 2013 through either May 31, 2014 or the date of completion of the 2013-14 greens renovation as certified in writing by the Recreation and Park Department General Manager, whichever occurs earlier).

At the end of the greens renovation period, the temporary reduced fees would expire by operation of law and be removed from the Park Code.

Background Information

The Recreation and Park Department is undertaking a renovation of the greens at Harding Park Golf Course in order to maintain an ongoing high quality of play at the course. To minimize impact to regular play and scheduled tournaments, the Department has scheduled the renovation to occur during the winter and early spring. During the renovation period, the Department will make a temporary greens area on the fairways available for play. Because the temporary greens area will not be of the same quality as the regular greens, the Department wishes to offer reduced greens fees during the renovation period to maintain a minimum level of customer activity on the course.
