

1 [Accept and Expend Grant - State Vocational Rehabilitation Services Program - \$135,600]

2 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health to retroactively**
3 **accept and expend a state grant in the amount of \$135,600 from the Department of**
4 **Rehabilitation to participate in a program entitled “State Vocational Rehabilitation**
5 **Services Program” for the period of July 1, 2010, through June 30, 2013, waiving**
6 **indirect costs.**

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8 WHEREAS, Department of Rehabilitation has agreed to fund San Francisco
9 Department of Public Health (DPH) \$135,600 to fund State Vocational Rehabilitation Services
10 Program, for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013; and,

11 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, Department of Rehabilitation
12 requires the City to enter into an agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with
13 the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 120198; which is hereby declared to be a
14 part of this resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

15 WHEREAS, The purpose of this project is to assist the Community Behavioral Health
16 Services manager in planning, organizing and coordinating, developing and evaluating the
17 work for the Department of Rehabilitation and Community Behavioral Health Services
18 cooperative contract; and,

19 WHEREAS, An Annual Salary Ordinance amendment is not required as the grant
20 partially reimburses DPH for one existing position, one Program Coordinator III (Job Class No.
21 2593) at .8 FTE for the period of December 1, 2011, through June 30, 2013; and,

22 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH did not
23 receive notification of the revised contract agreement until after December 2011 for a project
24 start date of July 1, 2010; and,
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1 WHEREAS, State Vocational Rehabilitation Services Program grant does not allow for
2 indirect costs to maximize use of grant funds on direct services; and,

3 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
4 therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend a grant retroactively
6 in the amount of \$135,600 from Department of Rehabilitation; and, be it

7 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
8 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

9 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
10 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
11 be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
13 agreement on behalf of the City.
