| 7 | WHEREAS, April is recognized nationally as Child Abuse Prevention Month, a time to |
| 8 | raise awareness and take action to protect children from neglect and abuse; and |
| 9 | WHEREAS, Among the most devastating forms of child abuse is filicide - the killing of a |
| 10 | child by a parent or caregiver - which claims the lives of approximately 500 children in the |
| 11 | United States each year; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, Research shows that custody disputes, separations, and high-conflict legal |
| 13 | proceedings are among the circumstances that can elevate risk, with an estimated one child |
| 14 | each week murdered by a parent or stepparent during such times; and |
| 15 | WHEREAS, On January 13, 2021, six-year-old Pierce Howard Hu was tragically killed |
| 16 | by his father while he slept, in a murder-suicide that has left an enduring impact on his |
| 17 | mother, Lesley, and extended family, including uncles Scott and Michael and grandparents |
| 18 | Howard and Therese; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, In response to this tragedy, and in memory of Pierce, a nonprofit |
| 20 | organization known as Pierce's Pledge was formed to protect children involved in family court |
| 21 | proceedings by advocating for accountability and firearm safeguards; and |
| 22 | WHEREAS, On April 12, 2023, the San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopted a |
| 23 | resolution declaring the first Filicide Awareness Week and voiced its support for the mission of |
| 24 | Pierce's Pledge; and |

| 5 | such as requiring clients in custody cases to disclose firearms and store them offsite with a |
| 6 | licensed third party during legal representation; now, therefore, be it |
| 7 | RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors declares the week of April 6 |
| 8 | through April 12, 2025, as Filicide Awareness Week in the City and County of San Francisco; |

| 10 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors reaffirms its commitment to the |
| 11 | goals of Pierce's Pledge and commends the organization's continued work to protect children |
| 12 | and empower family law professionals to put safety first; and, be it |
| 13 | FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors urges all family law attorneys to |
| 14 | take the pledge to keep children safe during custody proceedings, including requiring the |
| 15 | declaration and offsite storage of firearms by their clients, and to refuse representation to any |
