9	Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding	
10	Section 20.300, to read as follows:	
11	Sec. 20.300 Homeless Shelter Beds.	
12	(a) Findings.	
13	(1) Sleeping without shelter is unsafe, unsanitary, undignified and inhumane.	
14	(2) The City and County of San Francisco should do everything in its power to assist	
15	anyone who is without shelter to use shelter.	
16	(3) It shall be the policy of the City and County of San Francisco to provide a sufficient	
17	number of shelter beds for its residents who are without shelter in order to protect any	
18	and all people from the hazards and indignities of sleeping without shelter.	
19	(4) It shall be the	policy of the City and County of San Francisco to provide adequate
20	storage facilities at shelters.	
21	(b) The maximum number of homeless shelter beds available in the City and County of	
22	San Francisco shall be calculated at .5 percent of the population as determined by the 2000	
23	census. These beds shall be distributed in programs that serve single adults, families and	
24	victims of domestic violence.	
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1	(c) The Department of Human Services, or any successor department charge	
2	with the provision of homeless services, is authorized to promulgate rules and regulations to	
3	implement this section, and may provide services directly and/or through contracts. The	
4	determination of the apportionment of the shelter beds among programs for single adults,	
5	families and victims of domestic violence shall be within the discretion of the Executive	
6	Director of DHS, or the executive director of any successor department charged with the	
7	provision of homeless services.	
8	(d) The maximum number of homeless shelter beds shall be recalculated every	
9	two years based upon the census figures for the City and County of San Francisco released	
10	by the California Department of Finance.
