

1 [Accept and Expend State Grant – To support pest exclusion activities.]

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3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (DPH) to**
4 **retroactively accept and expend a grant in the amount of \$47,731.06 from the California**
5 **Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) to support the Light Brown Apple Moth**
6 **Program; for the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009.**

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8 WHEREAS, DPH was awarded a grant from the CDFA in the amount of \$47,731.06 for
9 the period of July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009, to support Light Brown Apple Moth (LBAM)
10 inspection activities at nurseries or nursery holding facilities; and,

11 WHEREAS, This grant allows for an extension of the Pest Exclusion/Light Brown Apple
12 Moth Program, which was also funded through the CDFA for FY 2007-08, and approved by
13 the Board of Supervisors through Resolution Number 329-08, File Number 080910; and,

14 WHEREAS, This project, as in FY 2007-08, focuses solely on prevention efforts
15 allowing Agriculture Inspectors to conduct Nursery Inspections, with no eradication efforts
16 whatsoever; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving these funds the CDFA requires DPH to enter
18 into a Grant Agreement (the “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
19 Board of Supervisors in File No. 081209, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
20 resolution as if set forth fully within; and,

21 WHEREAS, An ASO amendment is not required as the grant partially reimburses DPH
22 for four existing positions, including two Agriculture Biologists (Job Class #3450) at .20 FTE,
23 Manager I/Agriculture Commissioner (Job Class #0922) at .05 FTE, and Jr. Administrative
24 Analyst (Job Class #1820) at .02 FTE; and,

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1 WHEREAS, The budget includes a provision for indirect costs of \$8,439.27; now
2 therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
4 from the CDFA in the amount of \$47,731.06; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and
6 expend the grant funds pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code section 10.170-1; and,
7 be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City.

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate all positions
11 funded under this agreement as "G" or grant-funded positions which would terminate when
12 the agreement expires.
