1	[Initiating Landmark Designation Amendment - San Francisco Fire Station No. 44]
2	
3	Resolution initiating an amendment to the landmark designation of the San Francisco
4	Fire Station No. 44, located at 1298 Girard Street, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6194, Lot
5	No. 010, under Article 10 of the Planning Code.
6	
7	WHEREAS, Under Planning Code, Section 1004.1, the Board of Supervisors (Board)
8	may by Resolution initiate a Landmark designation; and
9	WHEREAS, Fire Station No. 44, located in the Visitacion Valley neighborhood, at 1298
10	Girard Street, at the corner of Wilde Avenue, Assessor's Parcel Block No. 6194, Lot No. 010,
11	was built in 1913 by renowned architect John Reid, Jr.; and
12	WHEREAS, While the great institutional building for Fire Station No. 44 was
13	constructed in 1913, the San Francisco Fire Department did not move in until 1915 to wait for
14	the delivery of a modern engine-driven apparatus as they phased out horses for fire rescue;
15	and
16	WHEREAS, Fire Station No. 44 has a brick façade, cornice work, and triple inset
17	balconies that evoke designs inspired by Italian villas; and
18	WHEREAS, There are a few San Francisco fire station buildings of this era still around,
19	but they are fairly rare; and
20	WHEREAS, A city survey conducted in 1976 resulted in pretty lukewarm public
21	response on this building but industrial and utilitarian structures, no matter how elegant or
22	thoughtfully designed, were not seen as important during that time; and
23	WHEREAS, Fire Station No. 44 is now currently one of the oldest firehouse in active
24	service and preservation; and
25	

1	WHEREAS, In partnership with the Visitacion Valley History Project, community
2	worked on identifying preservation projects to address the neighborhood's
3	underrepresentation in the city's official inventory of historic building; and
4	WHEREAS, Visitacion Valley currently has one designated city-landmark and through
5	a month-long campaign to identify the neighborhood's first city landmark designation in 2022,
6	residents and community members identified Fire Station No. 44 as one of the buildings they
7	would like to be designated as a city-landmark; now, therefore, be it
8	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby initiates an amendment to the
9	landmark designation of the Fire Station No. 44, located at 1298 Girard Street (Assessor's
10	Parcel Block No. 6194, Lot No. 010); and, be it
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that Planning
12	Department prepare a Landmark Designation Report to submit to the Historic Preservation
13	Commission for its consideration of the full historical, architectural, aesthetic, and cultural
14	interest and value of the Fire Station No. 44; and, be it
15	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the Historical
16	Preservation Commission consider what amendments to the landmark designation are
17	warranted to capture the property's full historical significance, and submit its recommendation
18	to the Board of Supervisors, according to Article 10 of the Planning Code.
