6 WHEREAS, Cancer is a group of diseases characterized by uncontrolled growth and  
7 spread of abnormal cells which, if not controlled, can result in premature death; and

8 WHEREAS, Cancer is predicted to strike one out of every three Americans with an  
9 estimated 151,250 new cases of diagnosed cancer in California in 2007; and

10 WHEREAS, The American Cancer Society is the nation's largest and most respected  
11 voluntary health organization since 1913 and has funded research which has contributed to  
12 every known method for detecting cancer and techniques for treating cancer thereby  
13 increasing the cancer survival rates from 10% to over 50%; and

14 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Relay for Life is a voluntary, community based  
15 coalition of local citizens dedicated to eliminating cancer as a major health problem through  
16 education awareness and financial support, benefiting the American Cancer Society's  
17 research and support programs; and

18 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Relay for Life is a community event that allows an  
19 opportunity to network with businesses, associates, family, and friends, with the same goal of  
20 making a difference in the battle against cancer; and

21 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Relay for Life's Paint Our Town Purple anticancer  
22 campaign is designed to unite our city though the display of purple; and

1           WHEREAS, The Paint Our Town Purple anticancer campaign is a chance for  
2 supporters to hang up purple decorations or wear purple attire to show their support to  
3 individuals living with cancer, and honor individuals who have lost their lives to the dreaded

5           RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors, hereby proclaims May 1,
