7 Election; and

8 WHEREAS, Proposition E enacted changes to the City and County of San Francisco's
9 Campaign and Governmental Conduct Code Section 3.218 to require all City departments,
10 boards, and commissions to develop statements identifying "incompatible activities;" and

11 WHEREAS, The Incompatible Activities Statement is intended to provide guidance to
12 officers and employees of the Board of Supervisors, the Clerk of the Board, and the Youth
13 Commission about what types of activities are incompatible with their public duties; and

14 WHEREAS, The Incompatible Activities Statement must be submitted to the Ethics
15 Commission by August 1, 2004; now, therefore, be it

16 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board to take all
17 necessary administrative steps to carry out of the intent of this motion, including the
18 submission to the Ethics Commission of the Incompatible Activities Statement for the Board of
19 Supervisors as approved by the Board.
