11	Section 1. Chapter 10, Article XIII of the Administrative Code is hereby amended by
12	adding Section 10.100-265, to read as follows:
13	
14	SEC. 10.100-265. REPARATIONS FUND.
15	(a) Establishment of Fund. The Reparations Fund ("Fund") is established as a category
16	four fund, as defined in Section 10.100-1 of the Administrative Code, to receive monies appropriated of
17	donated to support and implement the recommendations described in the San Francisco Reparations
18	Plan 2023 ("Reparations Plan") submitted from the African American Reparations Advisory
19	Committee, (established by Ordinance No. 259-20 and formerly codified at Chapter 5, Article XLVI of
20	the Administrative Code) and prepared by the Human Rights Commission. The Reparations Plan
21	outlines a variety of methods to provide restitution, compensation, and rehabilitation to individuals
22	who are Black and/or descendants of a chattel enslaved person and have experienced a proven harm in
23	San Francisco, such as being displaced from San Francisco by actions related to the San Francisco
24	Redevelopment Agency's activities during the period of urban renewal, between 1954 and 1973.
25	

1	(b) Sources of Monies. The Fund may receive any legally available monies appropriated or
2	donated for this purpose.
3	(c) Use of Fund. The Human Rights Commission shall administer the Fund. The monies in
4	this fund shall be expended solely for the purposes of supporting and implementing the
5	recommendations described in the Reparations Plan.
6	
7	Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after
8	enactment. Enactment occurs when the Mayor signs the ordinance, the Mayor returns the
9	ordinance unsigned or does not sign the ordinance within ten days of receiving it, or the Board
10	of Supervisors overrides the Mayor's veto of the ordinance.
