ALU Recommendation: Approval with the following conditions:

1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m.
2. Loitering (loitering is defined as “to stand idly about; linger aimlessly without lawful business”) is prohibited on any sidewalks or property adjacent to the licensed premises under control of the licensee(s) as depicted on the ABC – 257 dated 02/12/16.
3. The sale of distilled spirits in sizes smaller than 200 ml is strictly prohibited.
4. Not more than 15% of the square footage of the premises will be used for the display of alcoholic beverages.
5. The sale of beer or malt beverages(s) with an alcoholic content than 5.7 % by volume is prohibited.
6. The sale of beer or malt beverages in quantities of 16 oz., 22 oz., 32 oz., 40 oz., or similar size containers is prohibited.
7. No beer or malt beverages shall be sold in quantities of less than manufacturer pre-packaged six packs per sale with the exception of wine-coolers and beer coolers which must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities of four (4) or more.
8. Wine shall not be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 750 ml.
9. No noise shall be audible beyond the area under the control of the licensee(s) as defined on the ABC-257 dated 02/12/16.
