3 **Resolution retroactively authorizing the Department of Public Health to accept and**

5 **Control and Prevention for a total amount of \$969,243 for participation in a program,**
6 **entitled “National Human Immunodeficiency Virus Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS) -**
7 **San Francisco,” for the period of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022.**

9 WHEREAS, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has agreed to
10 fund the Department of Public Health (DPH) in the amount of \$969,243 for participation in a
11 program, entitled “National Human Immunodeficiency Virus Behavioral Surveillance (NHBS)
12 San Francisco,” for the period of January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2022; and

13 WHEREAS, The purpose of NHBS in San Francisco is to conduct bio-behavioral
14 surveillance activities among populations overburdened by Human Immunodeficiency Virus
15 (HIV); and

16 WHEREAS, NHBS will estimate levels, and monitor changes over time in HIV
17 prevalence and related risk and preventive behaviors; and

18 WHEREAS, The short-term aims are to collect and use data to measure prevention,
19 testing, and treatment program reach; guide the development and strengthening of these
20 efforts; evaluate prevention activities; and inform prevention policy; and

21 WHEREAS, Long-term use of NHBS data will improve prevention, care, and treatment
22 services to reduce the burden and incidence of HIV; and

23 WHEREAS, The grant does not require an Annual Salary Ordinance Amendment; and

24 WHEREAS, A grant increase of \$499,976 from \$469,267 was approved for the period
25 of January 1, 2022, through December 31, 2022; and

1 WHEREAS, A request for retroactive approval is being sought because DPH received
2 the award notice on August 5, 2022, for a project start date of January 1, 2022; and

3 WHEREAS, The grant budget includes a provision for indirect costs in the amount of
4 \$12,458; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That DPH is hereby authorized to retroactively accept and expend a grant
6 in the amount of \$969,243 from the CDC; and, be it
