3 **Resolution appointing Gregory Stewart, term ending April 22, 2004 to the Biosciences**
4 **Task Force. Residency requirement waived.**

6 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco
7 does hereby appoint the following designated person to serve as a member of the
8 Biosciences Task Force, pursuant to the provisions of Board of Supervisors Resolution No.
9 217-03, for the term specified:

10 Gregory Stewart, new position, seat 17, must be from an organized labor entity that
11 represents emergency service and public safety personnel, for the unexpired portion of an
12 eight month term ending April 22, 2004.

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the following findings:

- 14 1. The membership of the Biosciences Task Force has a goal to be representative of
15 the diversity of the City and County of San Francisco.
- 16 2. Applicant Gregory Stewart, a new appointee, who is not a resident of San
17 Francisco, is a person with experience that uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on
18 the Biosciences Task Force.
- 19 3. The Biosciences Task Force has attempted to fill the position, for which Gregory
20 Stewart was nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who has the
21 specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but has been unable to do so at this
22 time. The Rules Committee has certified that Gregory Stewart is qualified to serve
23 on the Biosciences Task Force.
- 24 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors concludes that there is no
25 other possible representative, who is a resident of San Francisco and who has the

1 specific experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this applicant, and who is
2 willing to serve on the Biosciences Task Force at this time; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the residency
4 requirement for Gregory Stewart, as allowed in cases where no qualified City resident, willing
5 to serve, can be found, pursuant to Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s)
6 appointed to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by legislative act of the
7 Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the City and County of San Francisco.
