

1 [Supporting Senate Bill 332]  
2 SUPPORTING SENATE BILL 332, WHICH REVISES THE CALIFORNIA BEVERAGE  
3 CONTAINER RECYCLING AND LITTER REDUCTION ACT (COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS  
4 THE "BOTTLE BILL").

6 WHEREAS, San Francisco is mandated by AB 939 to divert 50% of  
7 its solid waste from landfill by 2000 or face fines; and,

8 WHEREAS, Beverage containers included in AB 2020, the current  
9 "Bottle Bill," are recycled at an average rate of 75%, and those  
10 excluded are recycled at an average rate of 25%; and,

11 WHEREAS, Adding recyclable materials to landfill places fiscal  
12 and environmental burdens on San Franciscans; and,

13 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 332 would add more than 2 billion new  
14 containers to those covered by the "Bottle Bill" by including bottles  
15 for non-carbonated waters, juices, teas, sports and other soft  
16 drinks; and,

17 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 332 would increase significantly direct and  
18 indirect funding for the City through curbside and other recycling  
19 programs, litter abatement efforts and public outreach campaigns,  
20 resulting in improved recycling services and cleaner neighborhoods;  
21 and,

22 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 332 doubles the redemption value on twenty  
23 ounce containers, which stimulates higher recovery in this fast-  
24 growing segment of the soft drink market; now, therefore, be it

25 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco supports

1 Senate Bill 332, which revises the California Beverage Container  
2 Recycling and Litter Reduction Act (commonly referred to as the  
3 "Bottle Bill").




