2 EXTENDING CONDOLENCES AND SYMPATHY TO THE FAMILY OF MARY LI, A 13-  
3 YEAR OLD GIRL WHO WAS KILLED IN THE CROSSWALK OF BAYSHORE BOULEVARD  
4 ON OCTOBER 22, 1999, AND REQUESTING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SAN  
5 FRANCISCO TO ESTABLISH A TRUST FUND FOR THE FAMILY OF MARY LI.

6 WHEREAS, On October 22, 1999, 13-year old Mary Li was killed  
7 while crossing the Bayshore Boulevard on her way to school; and,

8 WHEREAS, Mary Li, who was an 8<sup>th</sup> grader at Francisco Middle  
9 School was in the crosswalk of Bayshore Boulevard and was crossing  
10 the street at a green light when she was struck by a pick-up truck;  
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Police Department is currently  
13 attempting to locate witnesses and information in their investigation  
14 into the cause of the automobile accident that killed the 13-year old  
15 girl; and,

16 WHEREAS, This tragic accident is the second time this month that  
17 a child has been killed on San Francisco's streets; now therefore be  
18 it,

19 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
20 of San Francisco hereby extends its condolences and sympathy to the  
21 family of Mary Li, and requests the City and County of San Francisco  
22 to establish a trust fund for the family of Mary Li.


