RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby authorizes MOCJ to accept and expend \$200,000 from the Office of Justice Programs, to administer the Weed and Seed Program; and

WHEREAS, the grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.
