10 WHEREAS, Code for America Labs (CfA) has selected the City, through its
11 Department of Human Services, in a competitive award process to participate in the 2013 CfA
12 Fellowship Program; and

13 WHEREAS, CfA Fellows are experts in web technology and dedicated to
14 creating innovative, code-based technology solutions to civic problems; and

15 WHEREAS, Under the 2013 CfA Fellowship Program, CfA will develop a web-
16 based technology solution to increase the ability of the lowest income San Franciscans to
17 access public benefits; and


18 WHEREAS, CfA has further awarded the City a grant in the amount of \$105,000
19 toward the full cost of its participation, to which the Department of Human Services and
20 Department of Information Technology will jointly contribute a \$255,000 match; and

21 WHEREAS, The Department of Human Services proposes to maximize the use
22 of available grant funds on program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant
23 budget; now, therefore, be it


1 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in

4 Services or his designee is authorized to execute any and all agreements or other documents

6 participate in the 2013 CfA Fellowship Program.
