[Grant Agreement - HomeBridge, Inc. - Contract Mode In-Home Supportive Services - Not to Exceed \$39,600,000]

Resolution approving an Agreement between the City, acting by and through the Department of Disability and Aging Services, and Homebridge, Inc. for the provision of Contract Mode In-Home Supportive Services, for a term of four years from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029, for a total not to exceed amount of \$39,600,000; for the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, with not to exceed amounts for subsequent years to be requested in spring 2026; and to authorize the Department of Disability and Aging Services to enter into amendments or modifications to the Agreement that do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution.

WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of Disability and Aging Services, wishes to provide grant funding for services provided to the community for contract mode in-home supportive services to eligible older adults and adults with disabilities in order to enable these individuals to remain safely in their homes; and

WHEREAS, On December 17, 2024, the Department of Disability and Aging Services, in coordination with the Human Services Agency, issued a Request for Proposals #1151 for In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) Contract Mode grant-funded services; and

WHEREAS, Homebridge, Inc. submitted a proposal and was the only proposer; and WHEREAS, The Department of Disability and Aging Services awarded the Agreement to Homebridge, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, On March 5, 2025, the Department of Disability and Aging Services

Commission approved the proposed IHSS contract mode services grant with Homebridge,

Inc. (the "Grant Agreement") in a total amount not to exceed \$158,400,000 for the period from
July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029; and
WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of
Disability and Aging Services, now wishes to enter into the Grant Agreement with
Homebridge, Inc.; and
WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b) requires Board of Supervisors' approval by
Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any
contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and
WHEREAS, On April 30, 2025, the Budget and Finance Committee considered this
Resolution and amended it to reflect the Department's agreement to reduce the not to exceed
amount to \$39,600,000 to fund the first year of services under the Grant Agreement, with the
expectation that the Department would later seek approval of an amendment to the
Agreement to increase the not to exceed amount to cover the remaining three years of the
term; and
WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No. 250224, is
substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to
be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement in
substantially the form contained in File No. 250224; and, be it
FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of
Disability and Aging Services to make any modifications to the Grant Agreement, prior to its
final execution by all parties, that the Department of Disability and Aging Services determines,
in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of

the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or

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1	advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement, and are in compliance with all
2	applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Grant Agreement being fully
4	executed by all parties, the Department of Disability and Aging Services shall submit to the
5	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. 250224
6	this requirement and obligation resides with the Department, and is for purposes of having a
7	complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved Grant Agreement.
