Effective immediately, I am removing my co-sponsorship from **Board File No. 240170** (**Planning Case No. 2024-003574PCA**) – **Density Controls in Three Historic Districts**, with the following comments:

- This policy has already been resolved. It was passed by a supermajority of the Board of Supervisors in March of this year, after the Planning Commission unanimously approved the necessary legislative fix using recommendations and direction from the Planning Department.
- The tailored proposal was supported for good reason. It redirected form-based
 density only for adaptive reuse projects in two tiny historic districts because form-based
 density combined with state-density bonus has incentivized developers to propose
 demolishing historic buildings and allows them to exceed existing height limits by more
 than three times. My consensus proposal still allows projects to add 33% density and
 form-based to adaptive reuse projects.
- This is a workaround to sound policy. The proposed amendment would undo this
 previously settled compromise and allow form-based density plus 50% State Density
 Bonus in those same historic districts.
