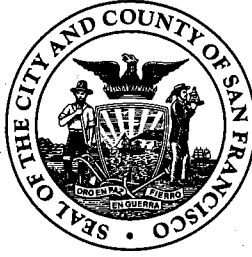



Although ultimately unsuccessful, our group of 16 local businesses was extremely impressed by Marc's commitment to this project.

Marc evinced tenacity, thoroughness and fair play during this two-year effort. He was empathetic and inclusive of interested parties on both sides of the question, and he knows how to run an efficient meeting. He researched the records of existing City BIDS, and he laid out a realistic timetable for a BID election process in North





Dear Committee Members:

I write to you in order to lend my strong support to the nomination of Marc Bruno to one of three available seats on the City's "Sunshine Ordinance Task Force." My understanding is that Marc is eligible for Seats 3, 9 and 10.

Marc has been an activist for many causes in North Beach and in the City at-large. I have personally worked with him on a Sierra Club campaign and, in coordination with the Telegraph Hill Dwellers-- Marc was then Vice President-- a successful effort to preserve additional open space in the northeast quadrant of the City. In addition, Marc has been a housing activist for those most in need, and, at the request of our former Supervisor, put together and emceed a panel discussion on Ellis Act Evictions in North Beach in 2006.

Marc included in this panel both Mark Leno and a representative of the Small Property Owners Association. He independently assured attendance by the general public by notifying local churches and posting notices, in both English and Chinese, throughout our neighborhood. Although Marc himself is identified as someone who is very much against these evictions, people on both sides of the issue trusted his commitment to fairness. The Ellis Act panel that he ran was balanced in approach and appreciated by all who attended. The result was informational rather than political. The skills he evinced in putting this together are, to my mind, exactly the type of skills needed on a commission mandated to make government as transparent as possible.

Marc Bruno is someone who is capable of stepping outside his own opinions and-- as far as this is possible by any of us with political passions-- genuinely empathizing with those with whom he disagrees. I believe this ability comes from his working with the homeless and poor throughout our City. He treats them as equals, as brothers and sisters and goes the extra mile to make them feel part of the larger community, no matter what their situation in life. I believe he will bring this compassion to the Task Force-- an attribute too often missing in City politics.


One thing I noticed about Marc's resume is that he does not mention his four year stint with the federal government at an office at the National Institutes of Health then-called the Office for Protection from Research Risks.

It is my understanding that this was then and remains today, under a new title, the sole Health and Human Services office dedicated to compliance with federal regulations regarding privacy and research transparency for both the general public and potential subjects of federally funded medical and psychological research. In this position- Marc was one of only two legal interns in a office of seven people-- he was responsible for overseeing the so-called "peer review groups" in the western states. Any research even remotely funded by the federal government fell under his purview.

His responsibilities in that office, I'm told, are closely linked to the balancing act often faced here in San Francisco by the Sunshine Ordinance Task Force. On the one hand, people demand open and transparent government records, and they want access to those records by virtue of being citizens. On the other hand, those records are sometimes protected by labor unions, state privacy acts and court decisions regarding those who are hospitalized otherwise might not want their information made public.

I believe that Marc's experience at the National Institutes of Health will be invaluable to the Task Force in clarifying these issues and helping to find meaningful solutions. For this and all the reasons I've shared with you above, I cannot think of a better candidate for these available seats on the Task Force.

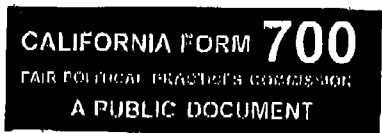

I am writing to express my interest in serving a second term on the San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance Task Force. As a member of the Task Force for the past year (seat #7), I have devoted an immense amount of my time and energy to furthering open government in San Francisco, and I believe the experience I have gained, along with the additional skills and experience I possess, make me an excellent candidate to continue serving in this capacity over the two years to come.

In my time on the Task Force, I've developed a deep knowledge of the Sunshine Ordinance, which I am confident will be an asset to the efficient and effective deliberations of Task Force over the coming years, particularly in light of the fact that several of the Task Force's veteran members will not be returning. As chair of the Task Force's Education, Outreach, and Training committee, I proposed and have implemented a system of press releases that makes the proceedings of the Task Force itself more accessible to the media and the general public. 

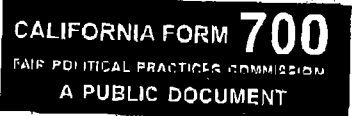

Board Qualifications:

The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force 2000 consists of a total of thirteen members, eleven of whom are appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The Mayor or his/her designee, and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors or his/her designee serve as non-voting members. All members must have experience and/or demonstrated interest in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. The City Attorney shall serve as legal advisor to the Task Force.

The members are drawn from the following categories: two appointed from names submitted by local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists, one an attorney and one a local journalist; one appointed from the press or electronic media; one appointed from names submitted by the local chapter of the League of Women Voters; four members of the public who have demonstrated interest in or have experience in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government; two members of the public experienced in consumer advocacy; one appointed from names submitted by New California Media, to be a journalist from a racial/ethnic-minority-owned news organization.

The term of each appointive member shall be two years unless earlier removed by the Board of Supervisors. In the event of such removal or vacancy during the term of office of any appointive member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term of the office vacated.

At all times, the Task Force shall include at least one member who shall be a member of the public who is physically handicapped and who has demonstrated interest in citizen access and participation in local government.

The Task Force shall advise the Board of Supervisors and provide information to other City departments on appropriate ways in which to implement Chapter 67 of the Administrative Code.
