Candidate statement of qualifications relative to demographic qualities of the City and County of San Francisco pursuant to Charter section 4.101(a)1:

In advocacy for women and minorities; increased diversity in the organized trades; economic justice for women, minorities and youth; pathways to high-skill/high-pay careers:

As a minority woman in an industry dominated by white men (electrical construction) I am both fortunate to have achieved my level of professional success and challenged to create new ways in which I can assist other San Francisco women, minorities and youth to enter and succeed in high-skill, high-pay careers in the organized trades. This is why, throughout my career, I have maintained an active role in community based organizations such as Tradeswomen Inc, and in AFL-CIO constituency organizations such as the Electrical Workers Minority Caucus (EWMC), Pride @ Work, and the Coalition of Labor Union Women (CLUW), all of which advocate for the rights of women and minorities at work. I am particularly excited about IBEW Local 6 plans to partner with the San Francisco Unified School District in creating a pre-apprenticeship program for San Francisco high school students interested in exploring industrial careers.

In addition to the aforementioned efforts, I also serve on the Board of Directors of Asian Neighborhood Design ("AND"), a San Francisco non-profit organization that offers architectural design services and a construction trades pre-apprenticeship training program. Most of AND's clients are people of color from disadvantaged economic backgrounds; and the majority are being reintroduced to their communities after recent release from prison.

In efforts to defend the rights of the San Francisco immigrant worker community:

As a business representative and public works contract compliance officer for IBEW Local Union 6, I represent the interests of IBEW members and our management partners; however, much of my work benefits non-unionized immigrant workers primarily from China, Korea, Mexico, and Central America. As immigrants, many of whom have limited English language skills, these workers are vulnerable and often taken advantage of; paid less than the wages required by law, asked to perform work in unsafe conditions, not compensated for overtime and otherwise abused of their rights. As I monitor public works projects in San Francisco, I often meet workers experiencing these unfortunate and illegal conditions. My position and training allow me to educate them on their rights under the law and assist them in seeking remedies through the San Francisco Office of Labor Standards Enforcement and other authorities having jurisdiction.

Since 1972, I have lived in the Haight, Noe Valley, Western Addition, Western SOMA, and West of Twin Peaks. I have nearly always traveled as a MUNI rider, pedestrian, or bicyclist, promoting lifestyle choices that serve people of all classes, ages, ethnicities, and gender/sexual orientations. I arrived in SF with no assets, having grown up sometimes homeless, providing me a unique understanding of lives here. I feel a responsibility to give back, and to that end, have served in a wide range of volunteer positions. As chair of the Bicycle Advisory Committee for over a decade, I have used the position to meet concerns and desires of others who share our streets, especially seniors like me, and my interracial children and grandchildren, the disabled, and women who have suffered from discrimination and cultural exclusion in their home cultures. I have officiated an LGBT wedding, and as a National Delegate for Boy Scouts, played a role in changing their membership policies.



I am pleased to urge you to reappoint Bert Hill to the Golden Gate Bridge Highway and Transit District Board (GGBHTD) of Directors. I am a fellow GGBHTD Board director, and colleague of Bert's on the district board's Transportation Committee.

The breadth of Bert's expertise from an educator in, advocate and strategic policy maker for housing, transportation and bicycle transportation brings an important and valued voice to the decision making on the board. Further, Bert's contributions are grounded in experience, his own and what he garners in his roles teaching bicycling and safety in an urban environment.

It is not surprising to consider his sometimes uniquely insightful comments when one learns of his career experience at Bechtel as a project manager and an IT expert. For example, his comments at the Transportation Committee suggesting the District look at trends and new demographics led staff to consider the viability of providing more recreational trip timing. He is a helpful source of information on matters that affect congestion relief in San Francisco, details of which are not always apparent to Board members from other counties. For example, when reconfiguration of some bus routes was discussed, Bert noted to staff that it would be helpful if the new Route 19 could go as far as Sloat Ave in San Francisco, resulting in staff studying the benefits of that alignment.

He advocates for accessible information, and suggested that the District web based applications and forms be available in different languages. Bert's attendance at Board meetings and meetings of subcommittees, even those to which he is not an assigned member where issues are discussed at length, is exemplary. Finally, and of importance, are his reports from national transportation conferences he attends that inform issues considered by the District Board.





The Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District consists of nineteen (19) Directors, as follows:

- > The City and County of San Francisco is represented by nine (9) Directors:
 - The Board of Supervisors appoints eight (8) Directors:
 - * Four (4) of whom must be elected members of the Board of Supervisors; and
 - * Four (4) of whom must be members of the public-at-large.
 - The Mayor appoints one (1) Director.

The Board of Supervisors eight appointments are subject to review and affirmation by the Board of Supervisors in January of each odd numbered year (two year terms). Once the Board of Supervisors approves the Motion appointing members to the District, a certified copy of the Motion shall immediately forwarded to the Department of Transportation.

The composition of the other members are as follows:

- > One (1) Director representing Del Norte County, one (1) Director representing Mendocino County, and one (1) Director representing Napa County, appointed by the Board of Supervisors of the respective represented county.
- > Four (4) Directors representing Marin County, appointed by the Board of Supervisors thereof.

"R Board Description" (Screen Print)

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Two (2) of the Directors shall be an elected member of the Board of Supervisors, one (1) Director shall be an elected member of a city council of a city within Marin County and designated by the Marin Council of Mayors and Councilmen, and one (1) Director shall be a member of the public-at -large.

> Three (3) Directors representing Sonoma County and appointed by the Board of Supervisors thereof. One (1) Director shall be an elected member of the Board of Supervisors, one (1) Director shall be an elected member of a city council of a city within Sonoma County and designated by the Mayors' and Councilmen's Association of Sonoma County, and one (1) Director shall be a member of the public-at-large.

The Board shall be the governing body of the District and shall outline rules of policy, approve plans, and vote or withhold appropriations to carry the same into effect. The powers and duties of the District are stated in California Streets and Highways Code, Sections 27160 et seq.

Compensated. Members are each paid \$50.00 per meeting day for attending meeting of the board and committee meeting on different days, but no member shall receive such compensation in excess of \$5,000 in any one year; except the president who shall receive compensation not to exceed \$7,500 in any one year. Each member of the board shall receive a sum equal to the necessary traveling expenses incurred by him/her in the performance of his/her duties.
