5 WHEREAS, The Bay Area Discovery Museum, a nationally recognized children's
6 museum, educates children through age 10 and serves as a resource for parents, educators,
7 and all who seek to enrich the lives of children in the Bay Area; and,

8 WHEREAS, A significant portion of the Museum's audience including 40% or 87,200 of
9 families visiting the Museum and 31% or 1,860 of family membership holders are residents of
10 the City and County of San Francisco; and,

11 WHEREAS, The Bay Area Discovery Museum makes an important contribution to
12 schools and the community groups with its extensive scholarship programs; 52% or 1,576 of
13 the children from 93 San Francisco schools come to the Museum on subsidized visits and
14 55% or 158 of the Museum's community program participants are from San Francisco; and,

15 WHEREAS, Community partners include but are not limited to the Tenderloin
16 Community School, The Creative Arts Charter School, Richmond District Neighborhood
17 Center, Lakeshore School, Morrisana West, Inc., KQED Center for Education and Lifelong
18 Learning, Reading is Fundamental, and the San Francisco Public Library; now, therefore, be
19 it

20 RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco endorses the Bay Area
21 Discovery Museum's plans to complete site improvements, and add new facilities to house
22 the Centers of Creative Arts and Early Learning and improve amenities for families.




