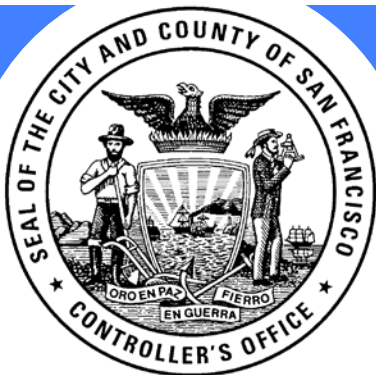

Designation of Agents Authorized to Obtain Disaster and Emergency Assistance Funding

Cal OES (California Office of Emergency Services) requires any applicant seeking federal financial assistance and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) to submit a Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution to be eligible to receive funding.

This proposed resolution has no financial and/or budgetary impact. It only designates and authorizes agents to act of behalf of the City and County of San Francisco (the City) for all matters pertaining to state and federal disaster and emergency assistance funding.

The proposed resolution is a universal resolution that will be effective for all open and future disasters declared up to three (3) years following the date of approval.

Designation of Agents Authorized to Obtain Disaster and Emergency Assistance Funding

The proposed Resolution designates the following three positions “to be the agents authorized to execute agreements for and on behalf of the City for disaster and emergency assistance funding from State and Federal agencies.”

1. Executive Director of the Department of Emergency Management
2. Controller
3. Deputy Controller

Virtually identical resolutions have previously been unanimously passed by the full Board:

- Resolution 414-19 – passed Sep 24, 2019
- Resolution 400-16 – passed Sep 13, 2016
- Resolution 334-13 – passed Oct 1, 2013
