| 7 | WHEREAS, The month of May carries significance to Asian American and Pacific |
| 8 | Islanders (AAPI) because of two historic events that occurred – on May 7, 1843, the date of |
| 9 | the first recorded arrival of immigrants from Japan to the United States; and on May 10, 1869, |
| 10 | the completion of the Transcontinental Railroad, a monumental project made possible by |
| 11 | primarily Chinese laborers despite discriminatory, unsafe conditions and without |
| 12 | acknowledgement and is now recognized as Transcontinental Chinese Railroad Workers Day; |
| 13 | and |
| 14 | WHEREAS, The origin of the Asian Pacific Heritage Month came from a former Capitol |
| 15 | Hill staffer, Jeanie Jew, who illuminated the need for the recognition of this important |
| 16 | community in highlighting her own story as a great granddaughter of a Chinese |
| 17 | Transcontinental worker, and Ruby Moy, the chief of staff of Representative Horton who |
| 18 | worked to make the commemoration possible; and |
| 19 | WHEREAS, Congressional representatives dating back to 1977, most notably |
| 20 | Congressmembers Norman Mineta and Frank Horton, introduced Resolutions to designate |
| 21 | official recognition for Asian Pacific Heritage, which eventually recognized the first week of |
| 22 | May as Asian/Pacific American Week; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, On March 28, 1979, President Jimmy Carter issued the first presidential |
| 24 | proclamation for Asian/Pacific American Heritage Week to recognize the significant |
| 25 | contributions of the Asian Pacific community; and |

| 1 | WHEREAS, In 1991, United States President George H.W. Bush signed into law a |

| 2 | Joint Resolution adopted by the Congress of the United States, declaring that the month of |
| 3 | May be celebrated as Asian Pacific American Heritage Month in the United States; and in |
| 4 | 1992, it was declared that the celebration would take place in May in perpetuity; and |
| 5 | WHEREAS, In 2005, Mayor Gavin Newsom embraced the idea of an annual official |
| 6 | celebration of Asian Pacific American Heritage Month in San Francisco; and |
| 7 | WHEREAS, The AAPI Heritage Month Celebration Guide is thoughtfully curated to |
| 8 | showcase AAPI events, activities, and educational opportunities from official celebration |
| 9 | partners happening in Districts across San Francisco; and |
| 10 | WHEREAS, To kickoff the month of May, the APA Heritage Foundation hosts the APA |
| 11 | Heritage Awards and reception to honor exceptional AAPI organizations and individuals; and |
| 12 | WHEREAS, 2025 marks the 21st year of the annual celebration of Asian American & |
| 13 | Pacific Islander (AAPI) Heritage Month in San Francisco, with this year's theme as |
| 14 | "Energizing The Next Generation," spotlighting the importance of youth leadership in the |
| 15 | community; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, The San Francisco Board of Supervisors honors notable AAPI residents |
| 17 | and organizations for their service, leadership, contributions, and achievements during a |
| 18 | Board of Supervisors Special Commendation Ceremony in the month of May; now, therefore, |
