2 APPOINTING MEMBER(S) TO THE LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION CITIZENS ADVISORY  
3 COMMITTEE; WAIVING RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT.

4  
5 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County  
6 of San Francisco does hereby appoint the hereinafter designated  
7 person(s) to serve as member(s) of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens  
8 Advisory Committee, pursuant to the provisions of the San Francisco  
9 Health Code, Section 1608, for the term specified:

11 Alecia Ashby, succeeding Angela Hodgson, (Seat No. 22, must be a  
12 parent), term expired, for a new four year term ending December 22,  
13 2001.

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors makes the  
16 following findings:

- 17 1. The membership of the Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory  
18 Committee has a goal to be representative of the diversity of  
19 the City and County of San Francisco.
- 20 2. Applicant Alecia Ashby, a new appointee, who is not a  
21 resident of San Francisco, is a person with experience that  
22 uniquely qualifies him/her to serve on the Lead Hazard  
23 Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee.
- 24 3. The Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee has  
25 attempted to fill the position, for which Alecia Ashby was

1 nominated, with an individual who is a City resident and who  
2 has the specific experience, skills, and qualifications, but  
3 has been unable to do so at this time. The Rules Committee  
4 has certified that Alecia Ashby is qualified to serve on the  
5 Lead Hazard Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee.

6 4. After exercising due diligence, the Board of Supervisors  
7 concludes that there is no other possible representative, who  
8 is a resident of San Francisco and who has the specific  
9 experience, skills, or qualifications possessed by this  
10 applicant, and who is willing to serve on the Lead Hazard  
11 Reduction Citizens Advisory Committee at this time; and, be  
12 it

13 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors waives the  
14 residency requirement for Alecia Ashby, as allowed in cases where no  
15 qualified City resident, willing to serve, can be found, pursuant to  
16 Section 4.101 of the City Charter that requires person(s) appointed  
17 to boards, commissions, and advisory bodies established by  
18 legislative act of the Board of Supervisors to be resident(s) of the  
19 City and County of San Francisco.


