

LEGISLATIVE DIGEST

[Administrative Code - Community Policing Plans and Foot and Bike Patrols]

Ordinance amending the Administrative Code to require the Police Department to create a Community Policing Plan (“CPP”) at each district police station, that, among other strategies, incorporates a foot and bike patrol deployment, and also includes a community process for eliciting input; and to require the public posting of the CPPs with a yearly update.

Existing Law

Currently, there is no local ordinance that requires the Police Department to create CPPs for each district station.

Amendments to Current Law

This ordinance would require the Police Department to create CPPs for each district station that, among other strategies, incorporates a foot and bike patrol deployment, and also includes a community process. This ordinance would require SFPD to publicly post CPPs and update them annually.

Background Information
