11 programs, including both indoor and outdoor soccer leagues for boys and girls; and,

12 WHEREAS, These soccer leagues rely on the City's parks to provide for areas for the  
13 youth to practice soccer; and,

14 WHEREAS, It is important that youth soccer programs, where everyone builds positive  
15 character through participation in a fun, family-oriented soccer environment, continue to be  
16 offered though the facilities of the Recreation and Park Department; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors does hereby urge the Recreation and Park  
18 Department that while reevaluating current practices and policies to determine the most  
19 efficient use of its park space for athletic programs to allow for public usage of the Marina  
20 Green for youth to practice soccer; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San  
22 Francisco does hereby urge the Recreation and Park Department to continue to engage in  
23 constructive dialogue with all stakeholders, including youth, on how to minimize the effect of  
24 budget cuts on all of its youth recreation programs.
